This project of the New Mexico AIDS Education and Training Center was designed to make information on HIV/AIDS services and treatments easily accessible in both English and Spanish and has become an international resource for information on HIV/AIDS.

The website of the Black AIDS institute, the first Black HIV/AIDS policy center dedicated to reducing HIV/AIDS health disparities by mobilizing Black institutions and individuals in efforts to confront the epidemic in their communities.
